GWEC Who is GWEC?

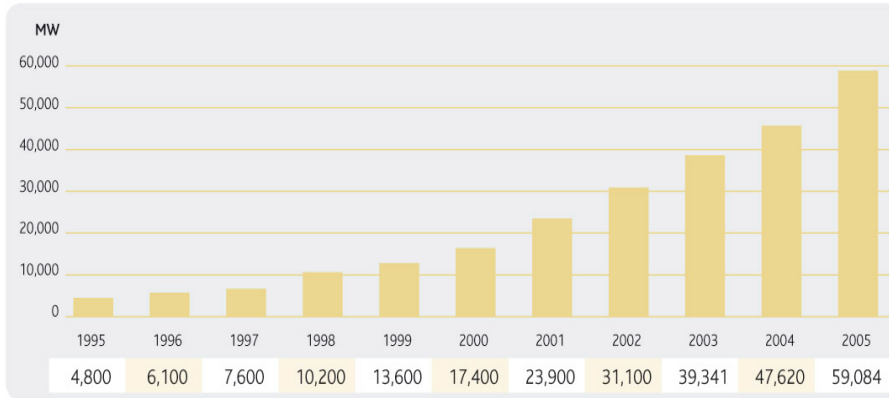
GLOBAL WIND ENERGY COUNCIL

There was a perceived need to create a global body to allow the wind industry to speak with one voice.

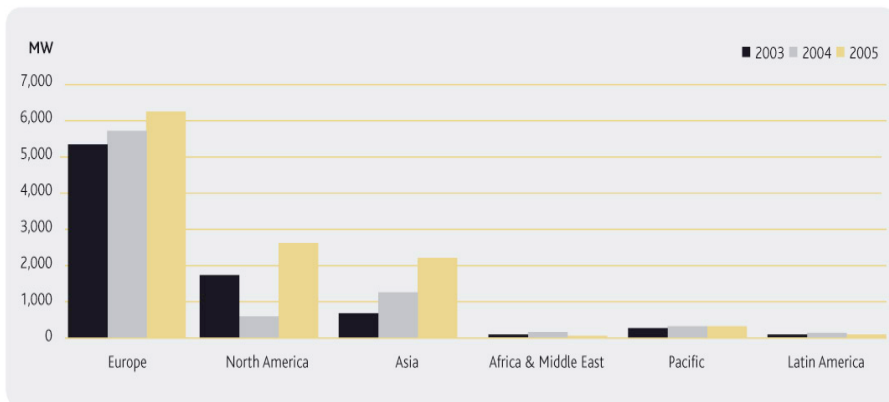
The founding members of GWEC were national & regional associations and internationally operating companies.

GLOBAL CUMULATIVE INSTALLED CAPACITY 1995-2005



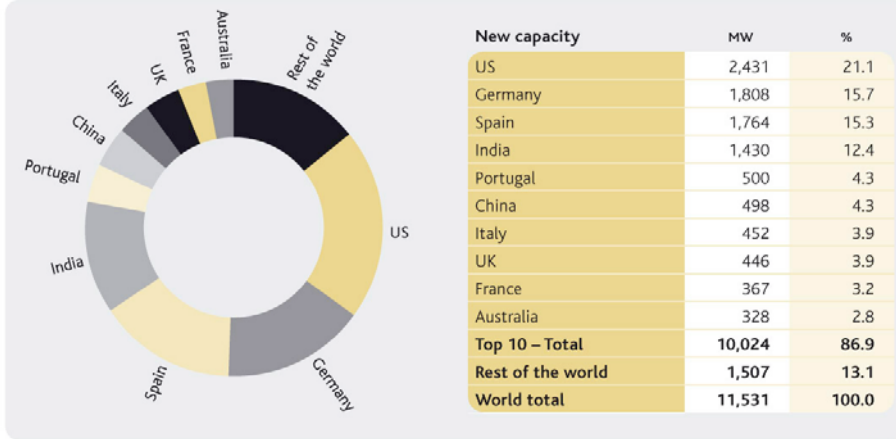

ANNUAL INSTALLED CAPACITY BY REGION



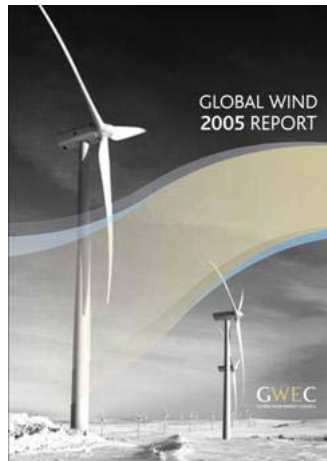
