Achievements to date (2)

- ❖ Need for a Business Council for Sustainable Development confirmed

- ❖ Formulated mission statement
 - Platform for the private sector
 - Advocacy group, dialogue partner
 - Facilitate mobilisation of finance for members
 - Exchanges and information amongst members



Achievements to date (2)

- ❖ Organisation and structure are now drafted
 - ASEAN accredited NGO
 - General Assembly, Board of Directors
 - Links with ASEAN organisation and bodies
 - Country representation

- ❖ Strategic priorities are now formulated
 - Sectors: renewable energy
 - Services: mobilisation of financial partners, networking and exchanges (technologies and business models)
 - Contribute and voice the private sector position in dialogue with policy makers

- ❖ Within the framework of the principles and orientations already decided

Expectations from the present meeting (3)

- ❖ Strategic priority : renewable energy development and energy efficiency - contribute to the ASEAN target of 10% of renewable energy generation by 2010: try and prioritise amongst the very long list...
- *Avoid duplication With what other organisation in ASEAN are doing (ACE, HAPUA, ...)*
 - ❖ Biofuels – small scale, for transport?
 - ❖ Biomass co gen
 - ❖ Waste to energy
 - ❖ Wind Power
 - ❖ Energy efficiency – Buildings, industry, ...
 - ❖ Mini hydro –
 - ❖ Off grid renewable energy
- ❖ What should be addressed during the first one / two years and how?
